Chicken notes:

- ◆ We order all pullets when available, which grow into hens. "Straight Run" orders mean the chicks were not sexed and they will grow up to be hens and roosters.
- ◆ All chicks are available on a first come, first served basis. We will do our best to get as many chicks as needed to satisfy our customers.
- ◆ Chickens are social creatures. We recommend purchasing no fewer than three chicks to create a family unit. This makes for happy and healthy chicks.
- ◆ If you're new to backyard chicks, review our Advice for Raising Chickens and Other Poultry guide for answers to FAQs, available for download at RenfrowHardware.com/resources
- ◆ Chickens are farm animals and some will die. Children should be prepared for that possibility. A word to the wise: hold off on naming the chicks right away.
- ◆ We receive all chicks certified disease-free. Chicks must be treated gently for several weeks.
